

**ST. JOHN NEUMANN CATHOLIC HIGH SCHOOL**  
**Parent Involvement Program (PIP)**

The Parent Involvement Program (PIP) was implemented at St. John Neumann several years ago to provide the school with a source of support for administrative, academic, athletic, social and fundraising activities that take place throughout the school year. PIP was established to equalize assistance through participation or financial donations so all St. John Neumann families essentially benefit all school students.

**What is required?**

Every St. John Neumann family must complete a minimum of 20 hours of volunteer time each school year.

- *At least 10 hours are required on one (or both) of two major fundraisers - the Amazing Celtic Race and/or the Lucky 7 Draw. This could be in the area of pre-planning, setup, working at the event or cleanup.*
- *The remaining 10 hours may be satisfied by helping in any of the administrative areas at the school, working at a school event (i.e. College fair), donating items to classrooms or donating food/beverages for specific events held throughout the year. You will be credited with 1 PIP hour for every \$30 spent (submit your receipts); similarly, your family will be credited with 1 PIP hour for each hour you spend if your donation is not a purchased item.*
- *10 PIP hours are credited if an individual maintains a position on the Home and School Board.*

Make certain to label every donation along with receipts/dollar amount spent!

Donation Invoices will be sent out in the spring - because we recognize that our volunteer's time is important, we ask for \$30 for each unfilled hour. Tracking of family hours will be enforced. You may check the St. John Neumann website for your hours due/completed.

2. 10 additional hours in any combination of the following:

  - c. Golf Cards
  - d. Classroom, athletic and club wish lists
  - e. After School Pizza
  - f. Lunch program
  - g. 2011 Graduation activities
  - h. Hold a Home and School board position
  - i. Concession Stand at Home Sports games
  - j. Teacher Appreciation Luncheon
